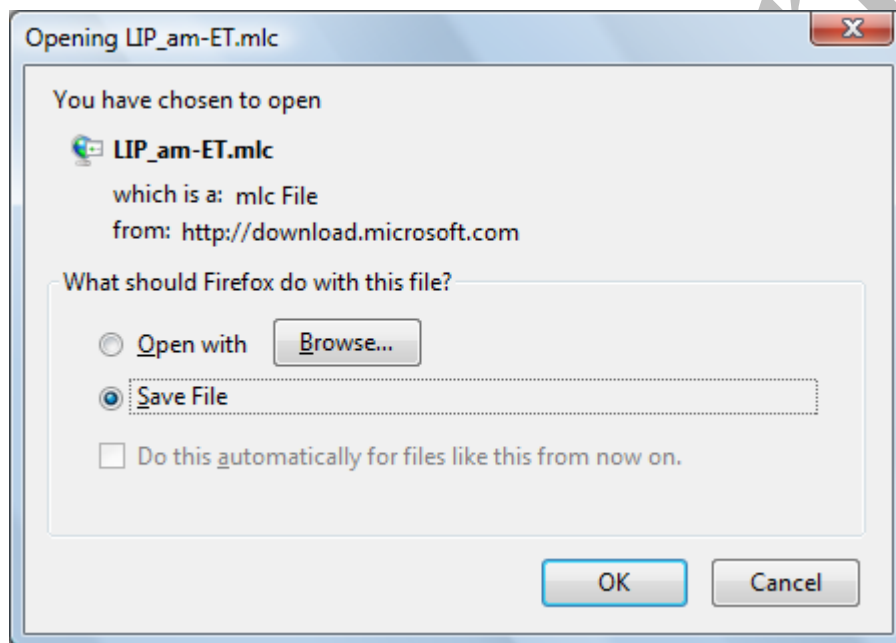


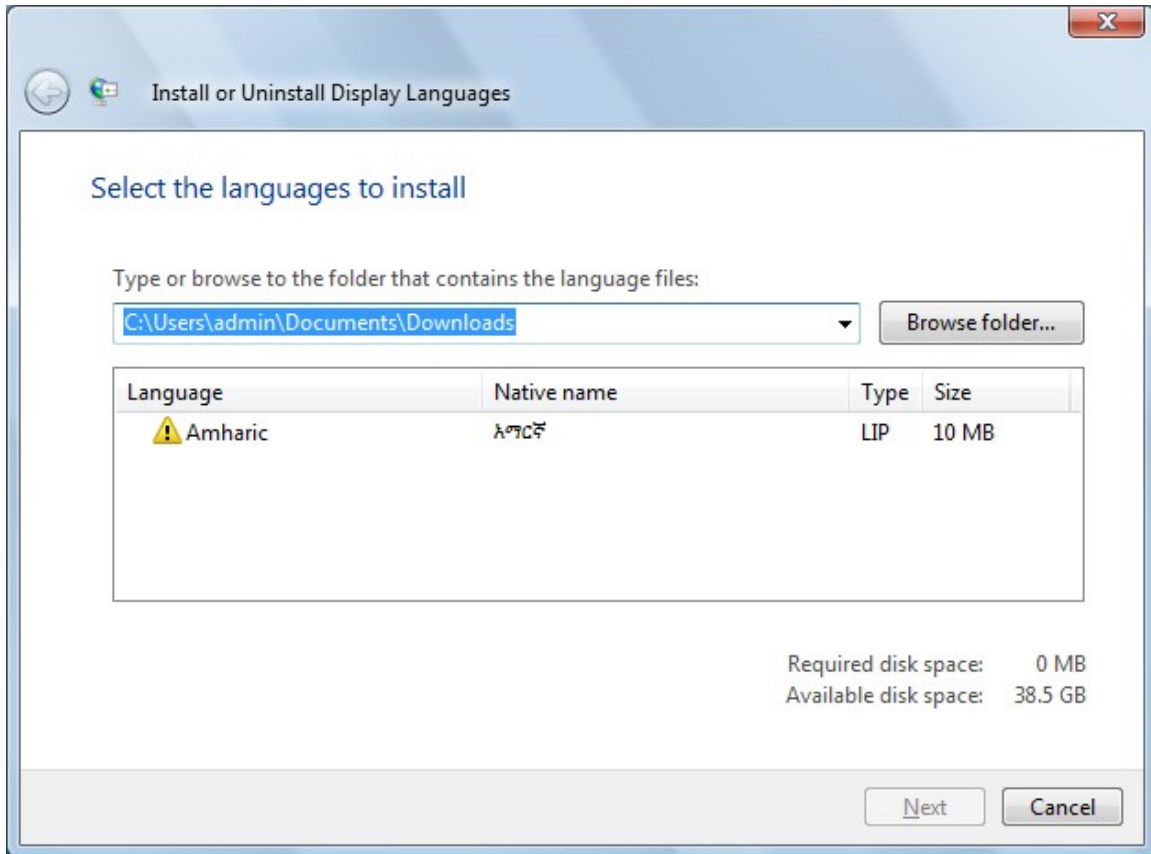
**NOTE:** The following guide is for Windows Vista only and you must have an administrator privilege on your computer, so make sure that you login with an account that has admin privilege.

1. Click on the [following link](#) to download the Amharic Language Interface Pack (Lip) for Windows Vista .
2. You will be prompted to open or save File. Choose **Save File**



3. You will be prompted to Continue or Cancel with the Title Windows Want your permission to continue, click on **Continue**

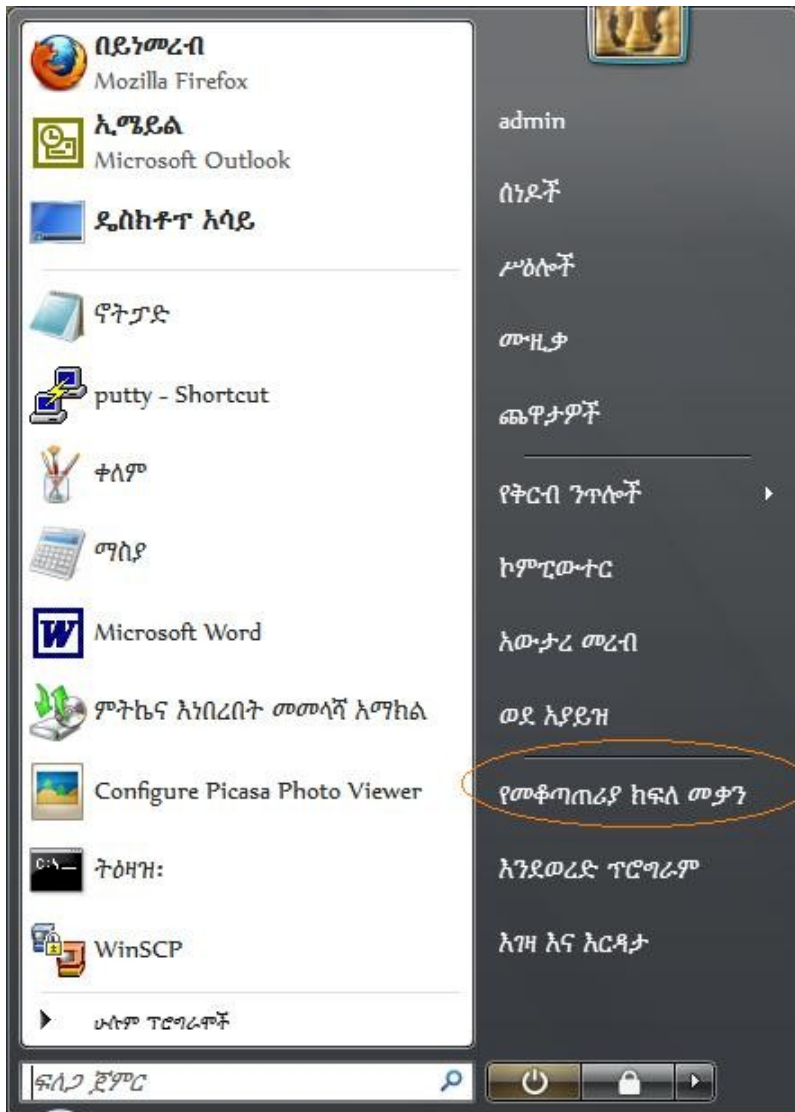
4. Select the language to install and you should see Amharic in the list, select Amharic and click on Next and the OS will do its magic. See below for screen shot



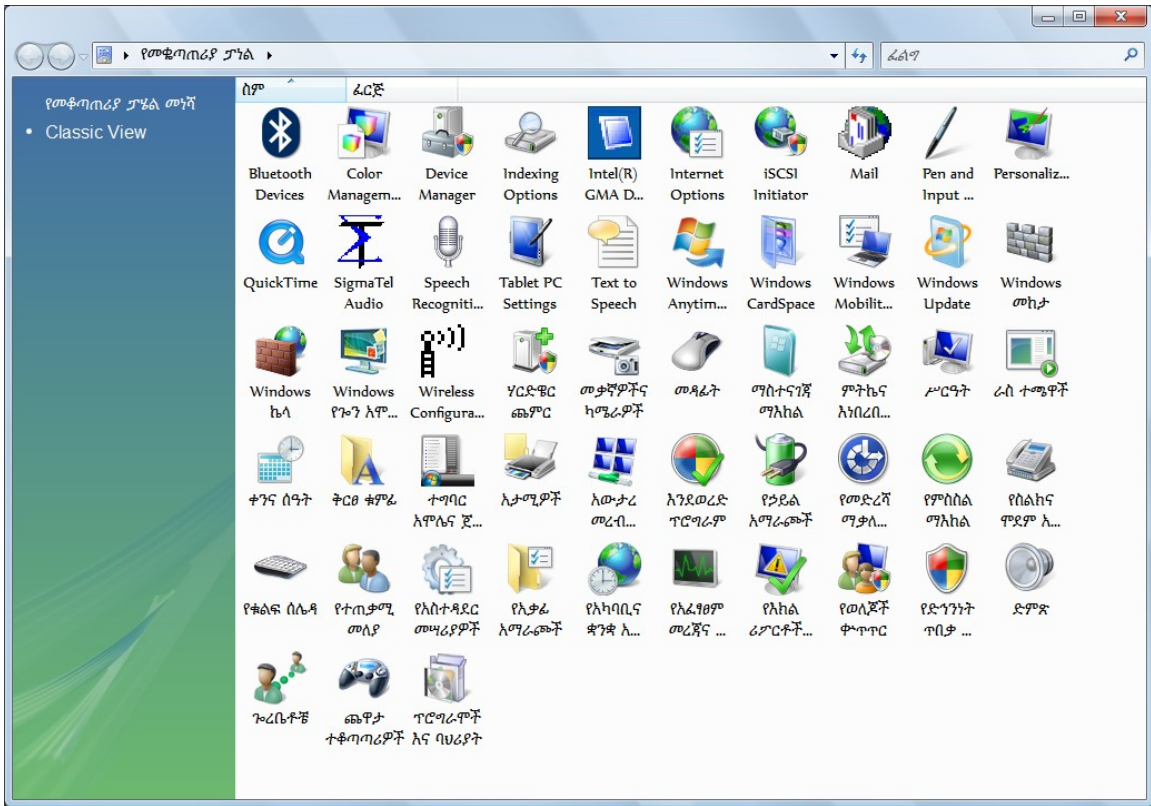
5. Once the installation is complete, all you need to do is logoff and login again and your Windows Vista will now be in Amharic.

If you need to change this back to English, you will need to simply change the setting from the control panel or windows task menu bar and once again you need to logoff and login again for the change to take effect.

To change the settings back to English, you need to do this from the Control Panel. (see below )



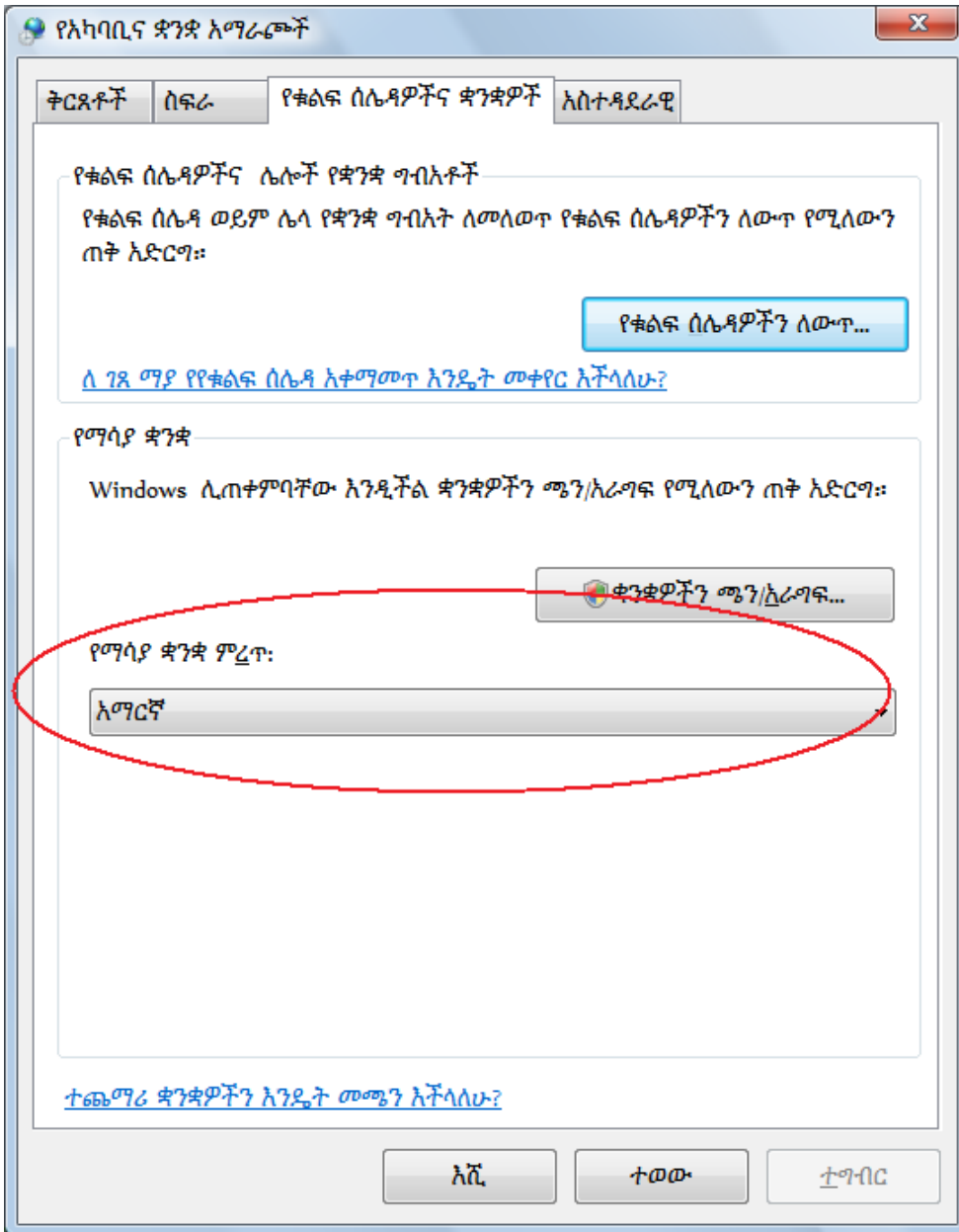
This is what the control panel looks like in Amharic
